#### 1. RESOLUTION PETITIONING THE CITY OF OJAI COUNCIL TO AUTHORIZE ENFORCEMENT OF CALIFORNIA VEHICLE CODE ON GCSC ROADS





## A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE GREEN CIRCLE SERVICE CORPORATION PETITIONING THE OJAI CITY COUNCIL TO AUTHORIZE ENFORCEMENT OF CALIFORNIA VEHICLE CODE ON TAORMINA LANE IN ACCORDANCE WITH VEHICLE CODE SECTION 21107.7

The Board of Directors of the Green Circle Service Corporation hereby petition the City Council of the City of Ojai as follows:

- A. California Vehicle Code Section 21107.7 ("Section 21107.7") permits the Ojai City Council to find and declare, by ordinance or resolution, that the interests of residents residing along certain privately owned and maintained roads, as well as those of the motoring public, will best be served by application of the provisions of the California Vehicle Code to those certain privately owned and maintained roads by reason of the proximity of such roads to or connection with the streets and highways of Ojai; and,
- B. Green Circle Service Corporation is the owner of two private streets known as Taormina Lane and Arundale Road which are substandard private streets serving approximately 78 parcels in the Taormina subdivision in the City of Ojai located at the terminus of La Paz Drive in the southwest portion of the City. Taormina Lane provides the primary vehicular access for these properties to the public street system of the City of Ojai.
- C. Free and safe pedestrian and vehicular access along Taormina Lane is often restricted by the parking of vehicles by adjoining property owners, and Green Circle Service Corporation lacks the effective legal authority to promulgate and enforce parking regulation due to the lack of applicable covenants, conditions and restrictions on the adjoining parcels.
- D. Due to the size and character of Taormina Lane as well as the lack of enforcement authority on the part of Green Circle Service Corporation, the interests of the residents of Taormina as well as the motoring public will be best served by enforcement of the California Vehicle Code on Taormina Lane and Arundale Road.
- E. Green Circle Service Corporation agrees to comply with conditions imposed by the City of Ojai for posting of signage as required by Vehicle Code Section 21107.7.
- F. This Resolution was duly adopted by the Board of Directors of the Green Circle Service Corporation, this 24<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2014.
